The planning application for Horkesley Park (application no. 090231) is finally approaching a decision by Colchester Borough Council (CBC). Our full response to the application is given on the [Horkesley Park Key Issues page](#), and our analysis of the key facts of the proposal and our objections. This is the fourth time Bunting and Sons have submitted their Horkesley Park proposal since 2001.

It is vitally important that as many people as possible attend the council meeting to demonstrate the continuing strength of opposition. We expect the form of the hearing to be as follows:

- Both 'sides' will have the same amount of time to present their case. Each speaker will only be allowed precisely three minutes. We think that at least three groups will be allowed to speak against.
- All Councillors can speak at the hearing. The Planning Committee should reach a decision on approval or rejection of the Application.
- If it is Approved, it will have to go to the Regional Office of Government. If it is Rejected, that should be the end of the matter, unless Buntings decide that there are grounds for appeal.
