Dear Member,

There has not been much to report on the Horkesley Park developments for some weeks but we continue to be very active on your behalf.

We have been in regular contact with the Planning Office in Colchester and are advised that there are a number of issues on which they require clarification from Buntings including those relating to the traffic studies before the Application can come before the Planning Committee of the Council. The Council is still awaiting formal final responses from the Highways Agency and the highways departments of Essex County Council and Suffolk County Council. The Planning Office is also reviewing all the many issues raised in the letters sent in during the consultation phase and these are being taken into account. It is not yet possible to set a date for the Council hearing but we believe that this is now unlikely to be before November at the earliest. When we do know the date, we will be sure to let you know and will need all your support at the meeting!

Please note that the Ramblers Association is holding a walk over the Little Horkesley footpaths, probably including those that go over the site of the proposed Horkesley Park, on Sunday September 27<sup>th</sup>, meeting at the Beehive at 10.30am. If you wish to join them, I am sure you would be most welcome.
