

Poster Removal Register

Have you had a SAY NO TO HORKESLEY PARK poster removed from your gate, wall or fence?

If so, please tell us so we can add it to the register.

If it has been removed from your private property, you can also report the removal to the police. The phone number to ring for non-urgent crimes in Essex is 0300 333 4444.

The police will give you a reference number for your theft. They will respond according to the number of reported incidents.

Many of us have noticed posters being removed over the past few weeks, but the evening of 30th March saw what seems to be the beginning of a concerted action. Since then we have asked people to notify us so we can keep a record.

Poster Removals

18th/19th April

- 1 sign in the private garden of Timbers, Court St was snapped off its base and removed (pictured above)

17/18th April

- 1 sign nailed above a barn door in Mill St, Nayland. (Mill St resident woken by loud noises around 2am!)
- several on private land at Perry Farmhouse, Bear St, Nayland

15th/16th April - all along London Road, Great Horkesley

- 1 from stable wall at Gwydyr
- 1 from under Gwydyr house name and slate sign bearing house name smashed
- 1 from back of Knowle Farm Barn stable
- 1 pole with poster on board snapped and removed
- 1 from entrance to Mount Hall
- 1 on stake in ground from Orchard Bungalow

10th/11th April

6 yet again, from roadside fence along the A134, near Tog Lane junction, Great Horkesley (pictured on previous page)

9th/10th April

6 again, from roadside fence along the A134, near Tog Lane junction, Great Horkesley
 6 from roadside fence of Hospytts, The Causeway, Great Horkesley
 1 outside house at Assington alongside the A134
 1 snapped off pole outside Willow Farm Barn, Assington
 1 from Sundown, London Road, Great Horkesley
 1 on drive to Orchard Percussion Studios, London Road, Great Horkesley
 several from inside an unlocked van in Little Horkesley

5th April

1 from the Old Vicarage Barn at Higham

30th/31st March

5 from roadside fence along the A134, near Tog Lane junction, Great Horkesley
 2 from privately owned verge at the end of the drive of a house in Little Horkesley
 1 from a tree in a fenced garden by Old House Road junction, Great Horkesley
 2 from trees on Vinesse Road
 4 from Thorington Street
 2 from outside private house in Stoke-by-Nayland
 1 from a pole beside a garden gate in Court Street, Nayland

30th March

6 from Boxted Hall Farm
 6 from Boxted Hall

Date uncertain

4 from barn wall on School Road, Little Horkesley
 7 from barn and stable wall London Road, Great Horkesley
 2 in Higham
 2 in Stoke-by-Nayland

We should also take this opportunity to also remind people that flyposting on any public structure (lamp post, telephone box, light fitting, noticeboard, etc) is illegal and posters should only be put up on private land with the owner's permission.
